

LAGUNA DE LOS TRES

EL CHALTÉN, PATAGONIA - ARGENTINA



13 miles / 21 km long

2300 feet / 700 m climb

7 - 10 hours

December - March

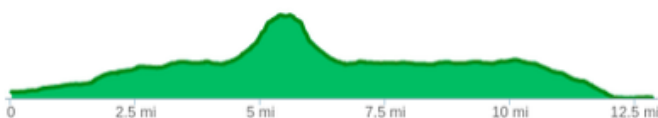
Moderately hard

No permits needed

This popular and well-marked trail near El Chaltén rewards hikers with jaw-dropping views of Fitz Roy and turquoise Laguna de los Tres after a steep and rocky climb.

TRAIL NOTES

- Start: Hosteria Pilar, gradual climb
- 4m / 6.4km: turn right toward campground, stream, final steep climb. This section is out-and-back.
- 6.5m / 10.4km: turnaround point at Laguna and Fitz Roy!
- 8m / 12.9km: turn right to finish out-and-back and continue toward El Chaltén, mostly flat.
- 9m / 14.5km: choose either direction
- 10m / 16km: merge back into single main trail
- 11m / 17.7km: start steep downhill
- 13m / 20.9km: finish in El Chaltén

- 3+ liters water, or 2 liters and purification method
- Lunch and plenty of snacks
- Rain jacket
- Rain pants
- Warm jacket
- Sunscreen
- Sunglasses
- Headlamp or flashlight
- Camera!
- Warm hat and gloves (optional)
- Hiking poles (optional)
